Welcome to the world of ABBA — let the music of MAMMA MIA! take you back to a time of innocence, disco, and fun — with a little bit of intrigue. This musical takes the joy of the hit songs by Benny Andersson and Bjorn Ulvaeus (original members of ABBA) and incorporates them into a fun story about a young woman, Sophie, trying to find her father. Her mother, Donna, had a heartbreak that sent her into the arms of two other men. Now a hard-working owner of a taverna on a Greek island, Donna is forced to confront feelings long buried when the three men of her past arrive due to invitations from Sophie. ABBA's music takes us joyfully, and sometimes poignantly, along Donna's and Sophie's (as well as the three men's) journeys.

This musical has been an extra special venture for me for multiple reasons. 
